

Giant Pandas:

Climate Change Threatens Their Main Food Source

According to a recent study published in the journal Nature Climate Change, the Qinling Mountains in Shaanxi province, home to around 275 wild pandas, are at risk due to the impact of global warming. The research predicts that the bears' main food source, bamboo, will be

significantly affected by

climate change, potentially

wiping out prime panda habitat in China by the end of the century.

As bamboo carpets the forest floor where the pandas reside, it is the sole item in their

diet and provides essential food and shelter. The

pandas play a crucial role as seed dispersers of the bamboo seeds. As they

move around, seeds and plant matter collect on their

fur, which is then dispersed over a vast area since these animals also climb

trees and swim.

Human development further threatens the pandas' survival by blocking their access to places where





bamboo is less affected by rising temperatures.

With pandas making up approximately 17% of the entire wild giant panda population, it is crucial to take action to protect these endangered animals and their habitat.
