

Adult Literacy Program Launched in Nai Basti, Lucknow

DEVI Sansthan launched literacy classes for underprivileged women aged 16-60 in the Nai Basti area of Lucknow, running popup classes in common spaces, homes, and challenging outdoor settings. A dedicated team of seven young women—Afreen, Anjum, Nisha, Ishrat, Mariyam, Heena, and Zeba—have been conducting classes for over 10 weeks, using ALfA books and math kits to teach literacy and numeracy through picture-based, activity-driven methods rather than traditional rote learning. The program created safe spaces for women to learn and connect, marking a significant community outreach initiative.
