Implementation has begun in 496 schools of Solan district, with an MOU in place for taking it state-wide in the 2024-25 session.

Haryana Rajasthan Uttarkhand

IIMPACT women's literacy program expanded to 9000 women across North India.

Ladakh

We are piloting a new way of disruptive learning - ALfA with 17000 ft Foundation in 30 selected schools of Leh district in Ladakh.

Uttar Pradesh

ALfA is being scaled up in schools across four districts: Shamli, Lucknow, Unnao and Barabanki. Adult literacy programs are also being implemented across several districts.

Madhya Pradesh

275 CM-RISE schools across all districts of MP are set to implement ALfA in 2024.

Mizoram

An adult literacy program implemented in partnership with the department of education has reached 5000 learners. There are now plans to implement ALfA in primary schools too.

West Bengal

An adult literacy program in partnership with IIMPACT Foundation has helped 1000 women become literate.

Odisha

Initiated as a research pilot batch of 10 schools will soon have their endline testing done, after which the program may be expanded to more schools throughout district Sambalpur.





Three Times the District's Score

NIPUN Assessment Test (NAT) by UP government shows that ALfA boosted FLN results by 2-3 times in places it was implemented.

In government's own NAT, Hilauli block topped in Unnao. 47% of Hilauli's schools were found to have reached NIPUN status,* three times the district average (15%) and double the state average (24%). This was due to ALfA's impact over just 35 implementation days.

Pedagogy matters!

*A 'NIPUN school' is defined as one in which 80% or more of sampled students passed the basic literacy assessment in each of Grade 1, 2 and 3.

A New Roadmap to NIPUN

Start BIG or small. Collect your own or 3rd party data and evidence. Integrate within curriculum and scale without a cost. Come and find out how.

SCALE

System-wide

Adopt across a broad geographical area to race towards universal FLN before NIPUN deadline.



Research

Implementation

Take up ALfA in one of the least-performing districts or blocks. Measure the impact after 45 days.

MODALITY

Incorporate into curriculum

Merge ALfA materials with the existing textbooks. Reduce some pages to avoid duplication, keeping overall printing cost low.



Scaffold for Impact

After the ALfA study materials are completed in 30-45 days, students move to more rapidly complete their regular textbooks.



TRAINING

Training Cascade

In-person training can be cascaded by a sequence of master trainers and trainers.





Chapter 8 discusses the ALfA pilot in Shamli, UP. ALfA was later implemented in 200 schools of the district, resulting in 36% of schools becoming NIPUN (state average: 24%)

The effect size of the project was **0.23 for Grade 3** students and **0.89 for Grade 5**... the results suggest there is significant value in pursuing the ALFA model in other schools if implemented in a coherent, structured, and coordinated manner.


